

I CAN'T STOP THE LONELINESS - ACCESSIBILITY RIDER

There are some colourful lighting cues throughout the show, but no strobe lighting whatsoever. There is a spillage of some liquid on stage and on the performers, but this does not interact with the audience / demand any specific physical capabilities / discriminate against those with any allergies or neurological disorders. Beyond this, there are no specific accessibility concerns within this show which are not inherent to the venue and its accessibility provisions, so far as the production team are aware. Attached below is a more detailed account.

LOCATION The Hen & Chickens Theatre, 109 St Paul's Rd, London N1 2NA

DATE 7th-13th August

TIME 7:30pm, except 11th (9pm) and 7th (4:30pm)

BASIC VENUE INFO

Entry to the building is via the main pub entrances. The theatre is on the second floor, which is accessible through a staircase. Service animals are of course very welcome. The bar will be open on the ground floor, offering a variety of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks. Free drinking water will be available. Toilets available downstairs, including an accessible toilet. The venue is not wheelchair accessible due to the staircase.

The show runs approximately one hour. There is no interval.

CONTENT OF EVENT

Trigger Warnings: Discussion of Self-Harm, alcoholism and depression. References to gun violence, death and police negligence. An actor will take off their shirt during the performance. Attendees can leave and re-enter the room as much as they like.

There will be no BSL interpreter or captioning available for this performance.

GETTING TO THE VENUE

The nearest station for both tube and overground lines is Highbury & Islington Station, which is a three minute walk from the theatre. Highbury & Islington Station has partial, Category B step-free access, allowing access between the street and London Overground platforms (1, 2, 7, 8) via lift, but it is not step-free for the deep-level Victoria line. Bus stops are roughly a 3-minute/ 0.2 mile flat walk away.
