### **VENUE INFO**

#### **Entrance and Pub area**

- ◻ The public and performers access the theatre through the Oxford Arms Pub located on Camden High Street and up a round staircase with a total of 20 stairs.
- ◻ Due to the venue being housed in a converted building, it is **not** wheelchair accessible.
- ◻ Under 18s are allowed to visit the theatre after 6pm, but will have to get in touch with staff, as we will have to admit them through a separate entrance due to pub regulations.
- ◻ Service animals are allowed into the venue.
- ◻ There is no reserved or on-street parking at the venue.

## **TRANSPORT TO THE VENUE**

### **BY UNDERGROUND (TUBE)**

The most convenient and popular way to get to the Etcetera Theatre is by using the London Underground. The nearest tube stations are **Camden Town** and **Mornington Crescent**.

#### **From Camden Town (Northern Line - Bank Branch or Charing Cross Branch):**

- **Travel Time:** 2-3 minutes walk.
- Camden Town station is on the Northern Line (Bank and Charing Cross branches). From Camden Town, it's just a short walk to the theatre.
- **Directions from Camden Town Station:**

- Exit the station onto **Camden High Street**.
- Walk down **Camden High Street** toward the south (towards the main shops).
- The **Etcetera Theatre** is located on your left-hand side, just before you reach the **Camden Lock Market** area.

### **From Mornington Crescent (Northern Line):**

- **Travel Time:** 5-6 minutes walk.
- Mornington Crescent station is a bit further than Camden Town, but still only a short walk away.
- **Directions from Mornington Crescent Station:**
  - Exit the station onto **Eversholt Street**.
  - Walk south, crossing over **Camden High Street** (heading toward the Camden Lock area).
  - The theatre is on your right-hand side, around 5-10 minutes' walk.



## **BY BUS**

### **Closest Bus Stops:**

- **Camden Town Station** (for routes 29, 46, 88)
- **Camden High Street (South End)** (for routes 29, 46)



## **BY BIKE OR CYCLE HIRE**

London is bike-friendly, and the **Etcetera Theatre** is located near several **Santander Cycle Hire** (Boris bike) stations, so you can easily hire a bike to get there.

- Nearest Cycle Hire Station: **Camden Road Station** or **Camden High Street** near the **Camden Lock Market**.
