We meet Rowan, a Torontonionian stuck in the daily grind, as he meets his untimely demise shortly after meeting the girl of his dreams. He finds himself in a place between life and death where a processing agent named Min reveals that he has the choice of returning to earth and reliving his life. *Grey Spaces* is a contemporary pop musical that explores the fatal errors of chasing perfectionism, and how the pressures to succeed in life can cause us to miss the beauty in the ordinary.

Set

The setting of the story shifts between the real world, set in modern day Toronto, Ontario, and an ethereal purgatory space called The Grey Space.

Each scene is represented by different combinations of tables, chairs, and a pair of doors on wheels, all of which are moved by the actors to set scenes.

Theatre Passe Muraille includes a balcony space overlooking the stage which will be occasionally utilized for dramatic effect.

The stage and set is otherwise bare.

Costumes

Each of the characters will be dressed in modern clothing of a mid-20s Torontonians. The character of Min will occasionally be dressed in slightly more formal attire, but still modern.
