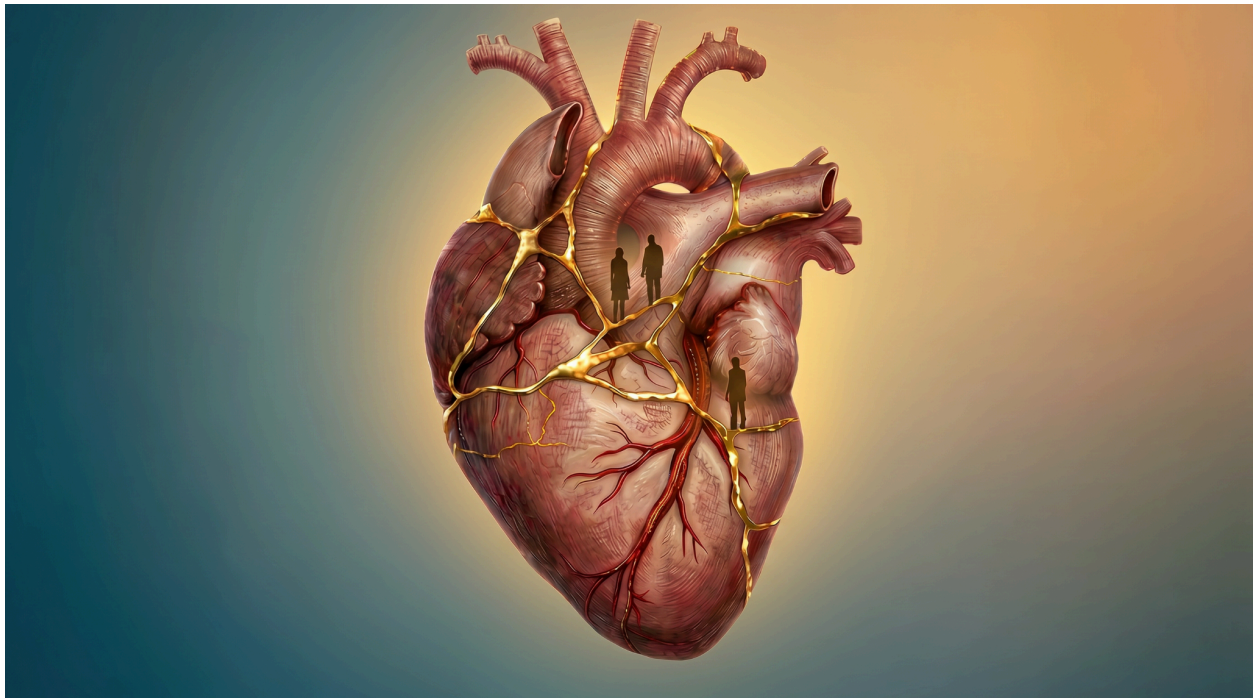

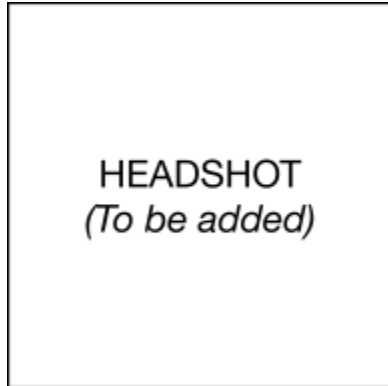

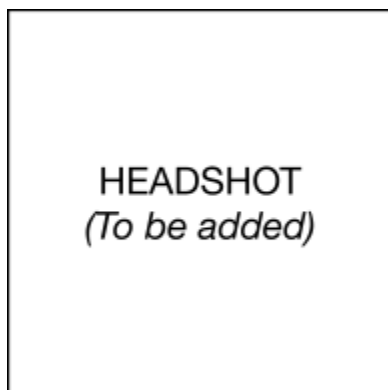

JULIUS CHAPPLE plays the role of ANDREW.

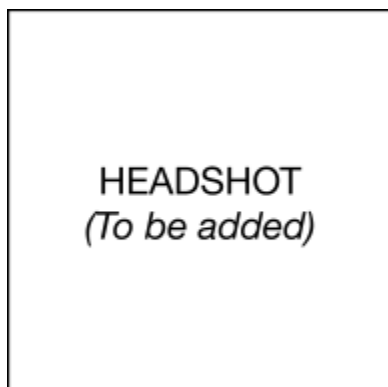
ANDREW is a man in his late 40s, who recently suffered a heart attack. He is a patient at the cardiac clinic.

NURSE is a woman in her early 40s. She works at the cardiac clinic.

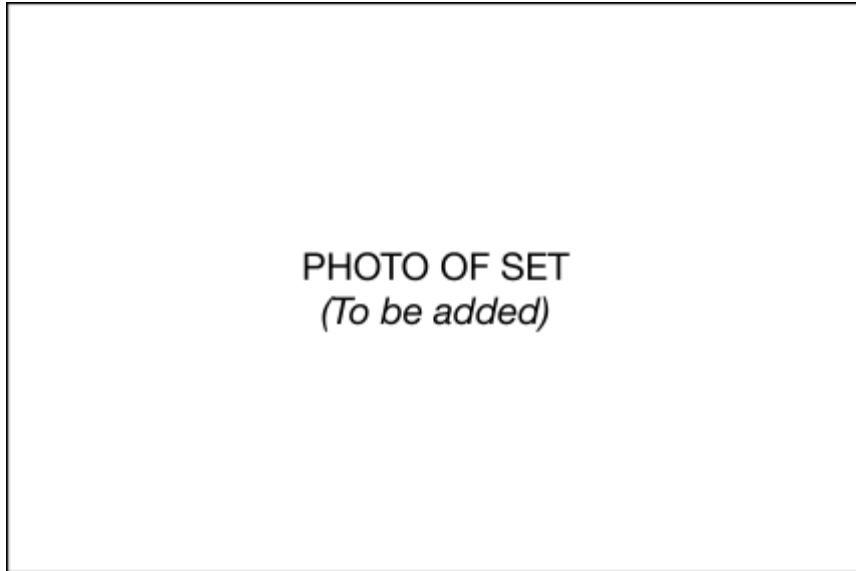
This actor also plays JEN, the wife of ANDREW, in FLASHBACK scenes.

Upstage centre is an Exam Room, with a treadmill.

Stage left is the Prep Room, with two armchairs.

Downstage centre is a common area with a long table used for FLASHBACK scenes. The FLASHBACKS illustrate a University Party, ANDREW'S Kitchen, a Bar, an Operating Room, a Hospital Room and ANDREW'S Childhood Home.
