VENUE APPROACH INFORMATION

We are really sorry to say that our Victorian building opened in 1895 does not have a lift. There are 17 steps (with a landing) up to the box office level and a further three steps up to the auditorium. There is a wide staircase with a rail both sides.

TIMINGS OF EVENT

House opens from 7.00pm
Show begins at 7.30pm
Interval commences at approximately 8.20pm
Second Act begins approximately 8.35pm
Show ends at approximately 9.20pm

CONTENT WARNINGS

Our show contains instances of strong language, crude humour and sexual references. The show is suitable for people 15 and over. There will be loud music sporadically throughout the show.

SEATING

There are 122 seats in the auditorium in a thrust-style layout.

ADDITIONAL ACCESS INFORMATION

In order to book access tickets, you will require a Nimbus Access Card or Digital Access Pass.
Assistance dogs are allowed in the venue.
There is an accessible bathroom for audience members.
There is a hearing loop available.
There is on-street parking available for permit holders.

GETTING TO THE VENUE

Highgate Station

Highgate Station, on the High Barnet branch of the Northern Line, is a 14-minute walk from the theatre

Take Exit 3 into the station car park. Heading away from the station, take the staircase on your right onto Archway Road. Turn right and walk to the pedestrian crossing by The Woodman pub. Cross over, and head all the way up Southwood Lane until you reach a mini-roundabout in Highgate Village. Follow the road to the right, and you'll see The Gatehouse pub: a large Tudor building. The theatre entrance is through the pub.

Archway Station

Archway Station, also on the High Barnet branch of the Northern Line, is a 19-minute walk from the theatre up a steep hill, but there is also a bus available which takes just 5 minutes.

Turn left out of the station exit onto Highgate Hill. The bus stop at Whittington Hospital is a 5-minute walk up Highgate Hill. You can take the 143, 210, or 263. Alternatively, keep walking straight up this road until you arrive at The Gatehouse pub.

Driving

There is free parking after midday in residents' parking bays throughout Highgate Village. There are also several Pay-and-Display bays available for parking before midday. Please confirm with nearby signs as this information is subject to change.

Parking is permitted on single yellow lines after 6:30pm on weekdays and all day on weekends, but please check roadside signs to be sure.
