## **Access Measures**

### **Mask Mandatory Performance**

At mask-mandatory performances, all audience members are required to wear a mask. This helps create a safer environment, particularly for immunocompromised patrons. Performers will not be masked.

The 3:15pm performance on Monday, July 6th will be a mask mandatory performance.

## Set

Our set consists of many boxes of varying sizes. Some are as big as a person, some are the size of a toaster, and some are all the sizes in between. At the beginning of the show, all of the boxes are slate gray and appear like concrete.

As the show goes on, colorful boxes appear. They are red, blue, and yellow. Some have designs like stars or flowers on them.

The boxes are continuously rearranged through the course of the show, as Gerry tries and fails and tries again to create structures like desks, towers, and arches throughout the show.

Our musicians will also have an area of the stage featuring live instruments including guitar, melodica, cajon, and keyboard.

## Costumes



Gerry's costume will be business casual. It will consist of dress pants, a shirt, a tie, and dress shoes. Darker, monochrome tones in the first half, then introducing more colour towards the latter half.

Lottie's costume will be bright, colourful, flowy dance apparel. It will consist of a yellow tutu, and a checkered yellow and pink shirt.

Both troubadours will wear relatively matching costumes centred around business casual and folk themes; dress pants, dress shirts, vests, suspenders, bow ties, hats and caps. They will have instruments and likely lavalier style microphones to allow for movement throughout the performance.
