### **Relaxed Performance**

Little Astronaut follows two female engineering students trying to hold onto their identity, ambition, and to each other in a system designed to wear them down. It is a show about silence, survival, and the strength women find in each other.

The show was written and workshopped by engineering students. The story reflects the real lived experience of multiple women studying engineering at the undergraduate level.
