Access Measures

Relaxed Performance

Relaxed performances are open to everyone, but the environment has been specifically adapted for those who are neurodivergent and may experience sensory sensitivities, folks with communication or learning disabilities, and people who would benefit from a more relaxed environment.

The 3:00-4:00 pm performance on Saturday, July 4 will be a relaxed performance.

Closed Captioning

Theatre Captioning is a form of live subtitling in which the actors' words appear as scrolling text located on a screen(s) located near or on the stage. Any speech, songs or sound effects are captioned, allowing people who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, neurodiverse or non-native English speakers to follow the show.

The 3:00-4:00 pm performance on Saturday, July 4 will be a relaxed performance.

Visual Story

A visual story is designed to give people who are attending the theatre an idea of what the experience will be like.

About EX-CHANGE OF WORDS

"*EX-CHANGE OF WORDS*" centers around Curtis, a 42 year old anxious avoidant and over-thinker, who is grieving the loss of the love of his life, while trying to maintain a friendship with his most recent ex-lover, and has simultaneously entered a new romantic relationship as 'the other man' (or 'the mistress'). This piece, which is loosely inspired by true events, explores the complexities that can be coupled with gay dating, age-gap relationships, interracial relationships, and infidelity. It explores grief and the intricacies of 'moving on', as well as navigating transitions in friendships and the differences between boundary setting and enabling mistreatment. This is a queer story, and it will have diversity within its cast in various ways of the term, as an authentic Toronto story should.

60 minutes with no intermission.

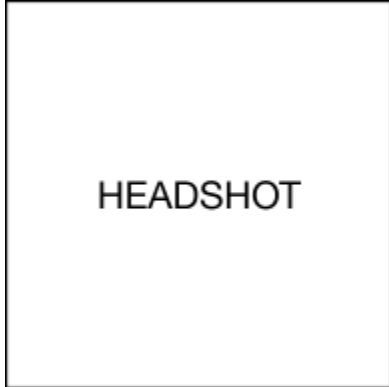

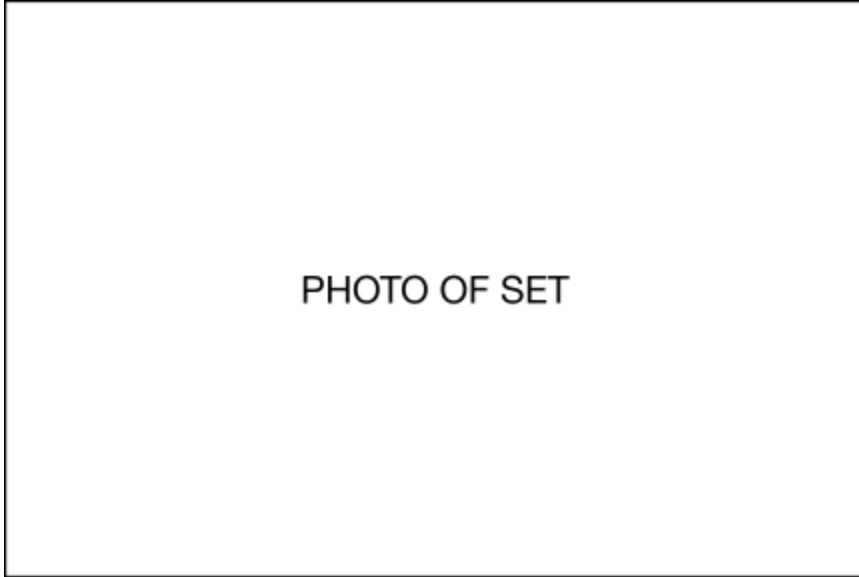
