BRANDON JAMES SIM plays the role of SIMON DEVEREAUX, the newly-elected Premier of Ontario.

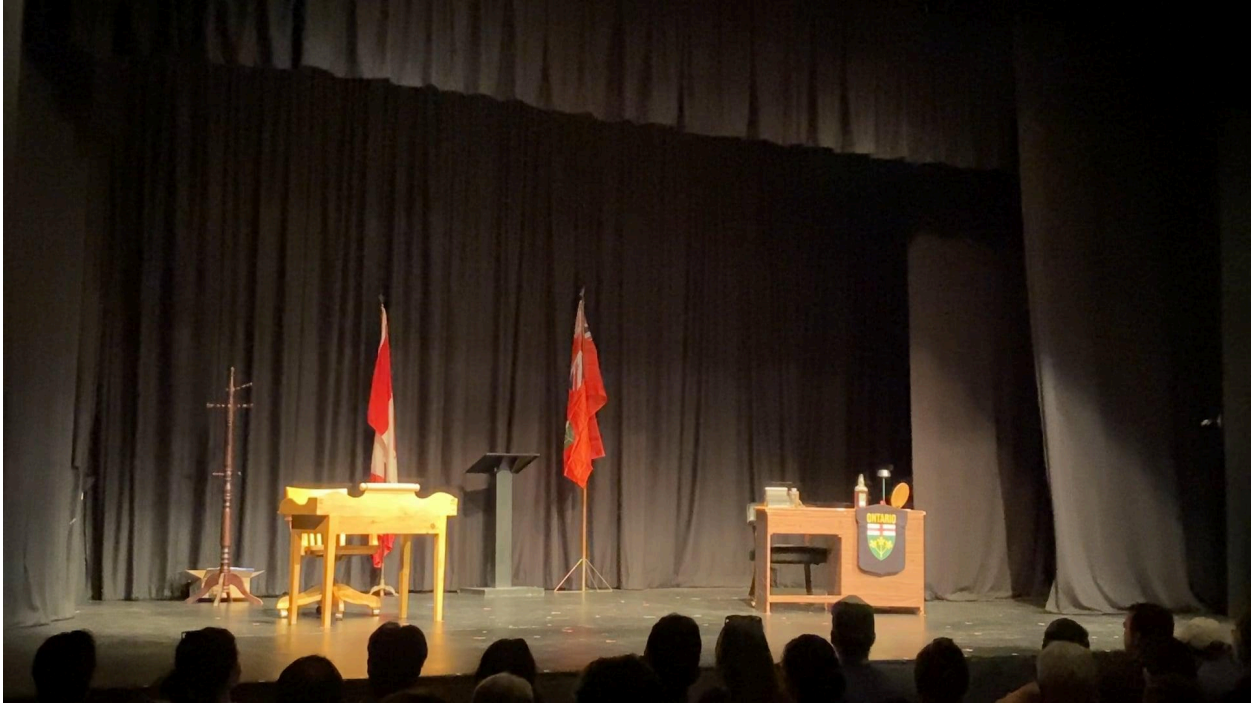


GAVIN SIBLEY plays the role of GRANT, a wonder kid politician and Simon's new Premier's Assistant.

The set is two desks, one slightly larger than the other. There is a provincial and a national flag in stands at the back of the stage. There is a coat rack and a podium. The podium rolls forward to centre stage under a spotlight when the Premier makes speeches.

Costumes

Simon wears a grey suit and tie. His tie changes each day.

Grant wears grey dress slacks and a blue paid, collared button-up short sleeve shirt.

Helen changes her outfit in each scene. Her colour palette moves from light to dark throughout the play and her clothes move from flowy to more restrictive. She wears a full fur coat with heels during Scene 5.
