Basic Venue Info

Access to The Oxford Arms has a singular step off the street, and access to the theatre is up a single flight of stairs to the first storey. The Oxford Arms offers gendered toilets on the ground floor.

Timings of Event

The play runs for 50 minutes each night, with no interval.

The box office will open 10 minutes prior to each show, and while the theatre itself will not be available pre- and post-show, it is situated above a pub and the building will be open all day (from 11am) and late into the night (until 1am on Thursday and Sunday, and 2am on Friday).

Content of Event

Trigger warning: this play heavily references colonisation, displacement and systemic genocide of an Indigenous Peoples. Audience discretion is advised. If at any point an audience member needs to leave the space due to the distressing nature of the story, that is welcomed and encouraged. However, due to the intimate nature of the show, re-entry cannot be guaranteed.

There will be no flashing lights, sudden loud noises or haze used throughout the performance. There will be no artificial cigarettes or smoke of any kind used by the performer.

Seating

Seating capacity of 42 people, on a raked auditorium over 5 rows of padded benches - the back 4 rows are accessed by a set of steps on one side.

Additional accessible information (BSL interpreter, closed-captioning, ramps, etc!)

There will sadly be no BSL interpreter or closed-captions for this performance, and there is no ramp or lift up to the theatre.

Photography/filming

No photography or filming is allowed once the performance has started.

Getting to the Venue

Closest tube station: Camden Town (Northern Line; 4 min walk from venue).

Best bus routes: 24, 27, 29, 31, 88, 134, 168, 214, 253, 274 and C2 (drop off either at Camden Town Station, Camden High Street or Kentish Town Road; 5 min walk from venue.)

Closest overground station: Camden Road Station (Mildmay Line; 8 min walk from venue).
