The main entrance to Aces and Eights is on the main street outside Tufnell Park station. The bar is up a few steps but there is an accessible entrance available. The stage area is located to the right past the bar, then to the left once at the bathrooms. Unfortunately, the stage area is down a set of stairs into the basement, so accessibility is not great.

The bar on the ground floor will be open, offering a variety of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks. Free drinking water will be available. An accessible toilet will be open on the ground floor throughout the event, and multiple toilets are available upstairs and downstairs.
