

## Company History:

Kicks and Giggles Entertainment was founded by Maddox Campbell to create quality comedy with a little extra kick. Their earliest work were video sketches created for YouTube in 2009, but over the last decade has expanded into producing monthly live comedy shows like “Perfect Match” (2014-2018, The Social Capital) and “The Know Show” (started 2019, The Social Capital), full sketch revues like “Binge Watching You Sleep” (2016, Buddies in Bad Times), and podcasts like the award-winning “Caverns and Comedians” and the award-nominated “Break A Wish.”

The Resistance Improvised marks Kicks and Giggles' first production at Toronto Fringe as a company, but the team we put together includes performers, directors, and stage managers who are all fringe veterans. The Resistance Improvised format was first performed in April 2018 and again August 2018 as part of the Toronto Celebration of Improv. The feedback from audience and performers was so positive we decided to bring it to Toronto Fringe, with all the bigger costumes, music, and special effects that Fringe deserves.

Maddox Campbell is an actor, writer, comedian, and producer based out of Toronto. Originally from New Brunswick, he studied at The University of New Brunswick achieving a Bachelor's of Arts (English/Theatre) and a Bachelor's of Computer Science. In 2009, he moved to Toronto to pursue a creative career and founded Kicks and Giggles to showcase his work. Since then he has remained a staple in the Toronto comedy scene as both a producer and performer.
