Getting to the Venue

By tube:

The Barons Court Theatre is in Zone 2, a similar distance from West Kensington Station (District Line) and Barons Court Station (Piccadilly and District Line), about 3-4 minutes walk from each in a fairly straight line along Barons Court Road. Other stops within walking distance are West Brompton, Hammersmith, Olympia (15 minutes walk) or Earls Court (20 minutes walk).

By bus:

Buses 28 and 390 stop in front of West Kensington station.

By car:

There are 3 parking spots in front of the theatre entrance, and relatively plenty of street parking in the immediate vicinity. Recent changes in parking rules in the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham mean that street parking needs to be paid at all times in the neighbourhood.

Seating Info

The Barons Court Theatre is a 52-seater studio with raked seating surrounding the stage on three sides.

Audiences will be seated throughout the entire performance.
