Parking

There are a variety of car parks in the nearby area. For the best parking options suitable for your needs, we recommend Camden Council's website, Parkopedia or JustPark. There are also a number of free street parking spaces on Drummond Street after 6.30pm. Between 8:30am and 6:30pm there is a standard charge of £2.70 for a maximum of 2 hours. Camden People's Theatre patrons can get a 10% parking discount to park nearby by redeeming the CPTHEA10 discount code on YourParkingSpace.

Local Public Transport

Camden People's Theatre is based 2 minutes walk from **Warren Street, Euston Square** or **Euston Station**. We're opposite Sainbury's Local, on the corner of Hampstead Road and Drummond Street. At the bottom of this page you can watch guided walks from each station. Euston Square is step-free between the street and platform levels. There are bus stops just outside of the theatre, approx. 100m down the road towards Warren Street station.

Bus stops:

R – Warren St Station/Euston Road (To New Oxford Street) 134, 24, 29, N279, N29

U – Warren St/Euston Road (To Baker St or Oxford Circus) 27, 88

S – Hampstead Rd/Drummond St (To Camden Town) 24, 29, N279, N29

T – Hampstead Rd/Drummond St (To Camden Town or Kentish Town) 134, 27, 88

Warren Street (Northern, Victoria), Euston Square (Circle, H & City, Metropolitan) and Euston Station (Northern, Victoria, Overground) are our nearest underground stations. Euston Square is step free between the street and platform levels. Plan your journey here.

In the venue

Camden People's Theatre is step-free from the street, as well as both ground floor fire

exits. The theatre, dressing room, bar/café space and accessible toilet are located on the ground floor and are all fully wheelchair accessible. The box office and bar are located on the right as you enter the venue with the theatre space to your left and seating area and toilets to your right.

For shows front door will open from approximately 6.30pm, with the doors to the theatre opening usually around 5-10 minutes before the start of each show. **For a 9pm show, we recommend arriving around 8.30pm** to allow time to collect your tickets. If you are a wheelchair user or require seating assistance, we will make an effort to seat you first. Please notify Camden People's Theatre in advance if you need assistance by emailing foh@cptheatre.co.uk stating which show you're coming to, and any specific requirements.

In the theatre the majority of our seating is on raised platforms, however we have one row on the front ground level. Please let us know if you're a wheelchair user so we can remove enough seats to accommodate you. This advance notice is helpful for us as removing the benches has a consequential impact on seating capacity in the theatre. If you would prefer to not sit in your wheelchair for the performance let us know on your arrival and we will arrange this for you.

When collecting tickets all we require is the name the tickets are booked under. If you are collecting a student or senior ticket, we ask that you bring a valid ID with you.

Door widths:

Single front door – 93cm /36.6 inches

Double front door (second entrance) – 148 cm / 58.2 inches

Entrance to the theatre – 104 cm / 41 inches

Entrance to dressing room – 86 cm / 33.8 inches

Corridor width of basement staircase – 101 cm / 40 inches

Entrance to basement performance space – 103 cm / 40.5 inches

Entrance to accessible toilet on main floor – 92 cm / 36 inches

Lift - 168 x 116 cm / 66 x 46 inches

Seat widths

Theatre seats are 46 cm / 18in wide. However, laid out in the space they are not touching so there is a clearance of around 50.5cm / 20in per person.

Toilets

There are gender inclusive and accessible toilets located in the basement and in the foyer, approximately 10m from our theatre space. The basement space can be accessed either via lift or stairs.

TIMINGS OF EVENT:

The timings of the event will be as follows, with the building open from 6.30PM:

20:30: Doors

21:00: Show start (duration of the show is 1 hour)

CONTENT OF EVENT - *Trigger warnings***, flashing lights, loud noises, music etc.**

Flashing lights, loud noises and music will all be used during the show.

The fictional characters created for this show are a satirical manifestation of the ideology and online subculture of the involuntary celibate ('Incel') communities which are rooted in misogynistic and extremist views which can include racism, homophobia, transphobia, ableism and violence towards women and girls. Discussion topics of self-hatred, depression, body dysmorphia and suicidal thoughts are also common amongst the Incel communities. Therefore, audience members should be aware that the dialogue, themes and actions displayed within the show may be triggering (see all potentially triggering topics listed below), and the show may contain offensive language and/or derogatory terms commonly used by Incel communities.

May contain reference to or themes of; misogyny, misogynynoir, sexism, racism, suicide, depression, body dysmorphia, violence, sexual assault, rape, homophobia, transphobia, ableism.

If at any point you feel the need to leave the room, there is a quiet space available outside of the room in the foyer which an usher or member of staff can direct you to discreetly. Attendees can leave and re-enter the room as much as they like.

Attendees will be seated for the show

All events at CPT are wheelchair accessible and guide dog friendly.

Medical assistance

We welcome any customers to the venue who require medicines, food or drink or specific medical equipment to manage a medical condition. If at any time during your visit you have any concerns please let a member of staff know. At least one member of Box Office staff working each night will have completed basic health and safety training. We have a basic first aid kit onsite, and CPT is 5 minutes away from University College Hospital and a 7 minute walk away from A&E. Both of these are located roughly opposite Warren Street station.

Assistance dogs

We welcome assistance and guide dogs in CPT and are happy for them to accompany you in any of our spaces at the venue and can join you in the theatre for events. We have a dog water bowl - please just ask our Front Of House staff. Please note that our staff are unable to look after assistance dogs in the foyer during performances.

Programmes

If an artist or company is supplying a programme for their performance, copies printed in a large, easy to read font are available upon request. Please notify us 48hrs in advance if you require an accessible programme.
