

Moving On: Trust and betrayal in Ontario's brave new economy. A rom-com.



Moving On is an exuberant comedy set in a one-bedroom Toronto apartment moments before the 2018 Cannabis Act becomes the law of the land. Broad farce blends with fast-paced dialogue to celebrate life in Doug Ford's Ontario.

Moving On was first staged as part of Alumnae Theatre's New Ideas Festival in March 2018 and was further developed through Alumnae Theatre's Fireworks Festival in November 2018.

- Lena Maripuu played Wendy in Bad Hats Theatre's production of *Peter Pan*. *Peter Pan* won three 2017 Dora awards in the Theatre for Young Audience's category, including Outstanding Ensemble Performance, before being part of Souleppper Theatre's Family Festival in December 2017 and 2018.
- Conor Bradbury is a member of the wildly popular Sex T-Rex comedy team. Sex T-Rex performs regularly for a loyal following at the Bad Dog Comedy Theatre, where they are Artists in Residence. Among their many awards are Patron's Pick, Best of Fringe and Critic's Pick at the Toronto Fringe 2018 for their Dungeons and Dragons parody *D&D Live!*
- The physical comedy of *Moving On* receives an adrenalin boost from fight director Neil Adams. Neil has worked as a stunt performer and stunt rigger in numerous movies, including *RoboCop*, *Suicide Squad* and *Flatliners*.
