



Night Journey, a Tale of Five Strangers and One Towering Epic, premiers at the Arts and Letters Club, July 3

Night Journey is an original, full-length Canadian play that explores the dynamics among five strangers in a college night class studying the Greek epic poem, *The Odyssey*. Each is broken in his or her own way; all are in quest of a way forward.

This challenging work of theatre is brought to life by *Night Journey*'s exceptional cast of actors: **Caroline Barr Ritchie, Brynn Bonne, Eric Braccioldieta, Paul Duder, Thomas Gough, Fred Kuhr** and **Renée Stein**. Our backstage crew is comprised of six talented students from the School of Performance at Toronto Metropolitan University.

Among the themes: live with passion and courage, and in the end, we each become Odysseus.

Night Journey marks the first time that **the Arts and Letters Club** has mounted a play in the Fringe Festival. The idea of doing a play first occurred in October 2025, when three new friends, having just met for the first time over drinks in the Club's lounge, decided to pool their talents and produce a new work for the Fringe. From then on, it was a mad dash by writer/director **Gregory Light**, writer/producer **Martin Jones** and actor/producer **Renée Stein** to conceive, write, assemble a crew, and mount the production.
