The Howland Company is an independent Toronto theatre ensemble, best known to Fringers for their "Best of Toronto Fringe" and "Patron's Pick" winning shows, *52 Pick Up* (2014) and *Lemons Lemons Lemons Lemons* (2017). Outside of Fringe the company has developed and produced numerous projects including their most recent production of *Punk Rock* (Nominated for 2 Dora Mavor Moore Awards for "Outstanding Ensemble Cast" and "Outstanding Costume Design"), a new adaptation of Ödön von Horváth's *Casimir and Caroline*, Susanna Fournier's performance text *take rimbaud*, and an innovative and intimate production of *The Glass Menagerie*. In 2016 they were the Emerging Company in Residence at Canadian Stage and they are also currently in partnership with The Gladstone Hotel where they run a monthly play-reading group that is free and open to the public. This October The Howland Company is set to debut the 2017 Pulitzer Prize nominated play, *The Wolves* by Sarah DeLappe in co-production with Crow's Theatre.
