She is the co-founder and artistic director of Rural Stages Productions. Director Alison Louder has previously assistant directed 2016 Patron's Pick The Harvester (Rabbit in a Hat Prod.) and has held a spot on the Best Local Actress Top 10 list in Montreal for over a decade.
