After Acclaimed Fringe Runs Across Canada, UNSUNG Makes its Toronto Debut with its Largest Production Yet.

TORONTO, ON: Have you ever wondered who caused some of history's greatest disasters? Who started the Chicago Fire? Which guard let in the Trojan Horse? **UNsung: The Accidental Villains of History** takes its audience on a trip through time and hilariously reimagines seven historical disasters...and the characters responsible. The UNSUNG team is wickedly excited to make its Toronto Fringe Debut with the Alliance for Canadian Musicals, playing at Theatre Passe Muraille starting June 30th.

Written by emerging Canadian composer **Mackenzie Langdon**, UNSUNG toured the Ottawa, Winnipeg and London Fringe Festivals, impressing audiences and critics alike. The Winnipeg Free Press awarded it four stars (★★★★), 101.5 UMFH called it "**Fringe at its best**", and Intermission Magazine says "**UNsung is knee-slapping and supremely well written**".

Bigger and better than ever, UNSUNG returns to the stage with an expanded cast and an exceptional creative team. Leading the Toronto remount is **Aster Roe Productions**, the company behind The Defendants podcast and An Artist's Journey (CBC Gem). Producer **Jane Aster Roe** has been behind multiple BroadwayWorld Toronto award-nominated/winning productions.

The hilarious cast includes **Tess Barão** (My Entertainment World Critic's Pick Nominee), **Nolan Rush** (Sweeney Todd, Horrorshow Productions), **Tyler Winder** (Sheridan College), **KC Martinez** (Brampton Music Theatre), **Jillian Peters** (T.Y.T) and creator Mackenzie Langdon.

Langdon is co-directing the show with **Jordan Robertson-Reid** (Education Arts Canada, Evil Dead). UNSUNG marks the directing duo's second collaboration, following A Girl Like You in Concert, a nostalgic celebration of the classic animated Barbie films, which played to a sold-out audience.
