

**Logline:** Krish and Kaushi reunite after 20 years, confronting an unspoken connection that blurs the line between friendship and something more.

**Synopsis:** After two decades apart, Krish (Iqbal Fasier) and Kaushi (Sumathy Balaram) meet again. Back in the present, Krish and Kaushi acknowledge how much of life they missed while apart. They speak about aging, grief, and the paths they chose. Kaushi reflects on the changes that came after Krish left to serve in the military, while Krish admits that their friendship carried a significance he struggled to define.

Another memory surfaces from shortly before his deployment. During a quiet walk, Kaushi confides her frustrations about her relationship with Dev, and Krish offers support while encouraging her to stay committed to Dev. When he reveals that he is leaving, the news creates a moment of vulnerability between them. The bond that cannot be defined or controlled struggles to express itself in ways society would shame.

As their final conversation draws to a close, Krish and Kaushi come to terms with the enduring impact they have had on one another. Though life carried them in different directions, their connection never fully faded. Through recollection and reflection, they discover that some relationships exist beyond simple definitions, leaving traces that remain long after time and distance have intervened.

In the end, a quiet gesture at Krish's gravesite serves as a final tribute to a friendship that shaped two lives.
