**Sincerely, E - Growing Pains Set to the Rhythm of the Swinging Sixties**

With a suitcase, a dream, and a one-way journey to London, a young Caribbean woman leaves everything she knows behind in search of a brighter future. Running at Soulpepper Theatre's Kevin & Roger Garland Cabaret, this 60-minute piece traces her journey through migration, love, and the search for belonging. Inspired by the legacy of the Windrush generation Sincerely, E honours and celebrates their lasting contributions to Toronto's vibrant Caribbean community.

Written and directed by Neisha Pierre, a Toronto Fringe TENT (Theatre Entrepreneurs' Network & Training) alum, Sincerely, E makes its Fringe debut as a heartfelt tribute to the writer's late grandfather and his journey to Canada.
