Gabriel wakes up in the middle of the night trapped in the house of his deceased grandfather. Stumbling through a series of waking nightmares, he picks away at the walls of his psyche in search for a sense of authenticity. A startlingly hopeful exploration of loss and grief, *Little Eden* is a journey through the mind of a man defined by his past and threatened by his future.

Gabriel lends himself in practice to the *bouffon*— there is a constant battle between his affliction and his youth. Because if we relish in the pain, perhaps beauty exists despite it all. As he questions the meaning of life? The real challenge is if you, as an audience member, can answer these questions yourself.

Little Eden is a play about making the most of a world that constantly seems to be set up against you. From a uniquely and youthfully queer, cross-Canadian perspective, we explore how each one of us is at odds with our past, while trying to write our own futures.
