With absolutely no group rehearsal, these brave performers will only meet one another for the first time an hour before the curtain rises. **The only rule: Don't stop. No matter what.**

Pioneered by Marion Abbott in 2014, CMTTP has received widespread acclaim across North America by combining confidentiality with their creative take on producing theatre.

"There's a very visceral thrill in watching an audience of people who love a show, and love a song, and never thought they'd hear it in their lives, getting to stand up and stomp and hoot and holler at a truly outstanding rendition.
