THE HUNS: SYNOPSIS

The morning after a break-in at a tech company, three feuding co-workers assemble for a conference call to discuss the burglary. As tensions within the group begin to rise and unspoken motivations are exposed, what starts as a civilized, professional meeting swiftly devolves into a brutal showdown that puts everyone's careers-- and their hopes for future happiness-- in jeopardy.

A visceral, unnerving, and laugh-out-loud look at modern workplace culture, *The Huns* is a fast-paced, menacing new comedy about millennial anxieties, minor revolutions, and modern-day barbarians.

Though darkly comedic, the play examines the serious themes of depression, anxiety, and mental health in the workplace. Its characters are locked in a brutal and desperate conflict with each other, and with the world around them. *The Huns* is a scathingly frank examination of a floundering generation's relationship to work, a satirical critique of the culture we've become, and a rallying battle-cry for radical change.
