

Synopsis for **Fray**

Meet the Mitchells! Sarcastic Bill, high-kicking Rose, and mopey Meg. They're tightly knit and tightly wound - just your regular, average, totally normal, '80s family. Come on in, make yourself at home and share in the everyday joy, fear, resentment, and existential dread!

Tied together, and to the set, the members of the Mitchell family, matriarch Rose, patriarch Bill, and daughter Meg, go about their infinite loop of day, getting more and more tangled up in the strings, each other, and the furniture, as they tease, taunt, and rage at one another, all while daughter Meg struggles to find an exit for herself.

Old grudges will surface, buttons will be pushed (in the way only family can push them), and new ambitions will emerge, as Rose, Bill, and Meg, push and pull against their love and loathing for one another.

Drawing on physical theatre, contemporary dance, and, in one memorable sequence, showtune choreography, Fray crackles with energy, and will have the audience laughing, gasping, and wincing at how painfully familiar it all is.
