Ten years ago, Matti McLean stumbled into body painting with The Human Canvas Project. Now after a half decade away from this passion, he seeks to create new experience by telling the story from his side of the brush, while live painting a volunteer in front of the audience.

With the live painting of a model, this show tackles themes of religious trauma, artistic burnout, queer identity - all with a heaping helping of insecurity and self deprecation.
