Graham will send along his act so that a surrogate can do the show in Toronto in his stead. It's a win-win and as far as Graham knows, it's a first.

The show itself is a tale of death in a very, very small town. It is a meditation on death and it's many mysteries and what it's like to be...not here.

It's funny though, you see, because Graham Clark is a comedian that has been working in Canada so long he once had a Myspace page.

So come, laugh death in the face, even if you can't laugh at Graham directly in the face.
