

D.E.I. Another Day: A Mafia Heir Brings Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion to the Family Business

What happens when a recent Ontario college graduate inherits a criminal empire, and decides it needs a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion strategy? **D.E.I. Another Day**, an original comedy from Toronto-based multilingual improv troupe **HINPROV**, makes its Toronto Fringe Festival debut with a fast-paced story about identity, leadership, and the challenges of changing an organization from the inside out. Presented at the **2026 Toronto Fringe Festival**, the show follows Amit, a reluctant successor who takes over his father's mafia organization and discovers that leading a company (even a criminal one) requires courage, conviction, and a vision for the future.

Blending absurd comedy, heartfelt moments, and a uniquely South Asian perspective, **D.E.I. Another Day** explores generational expectations, workplace culture, and what it means to create belonging in places that were never designed for change. The result is a timely satire that asks whether even the most entrenched institutions can evolve.

The production is created by members of **HINPROV**, one of Toronto's first-of-its-kind multi-lingual improv troupes, known for celebrating South Asian stories through comedy, improvisation, and original theatrical work. Drawing on the company's experience creating culturally specific comedy for diverse audiences, **D.E.I. Another Day** combines the energy of improv with a scripted narrative that speaks to contemporary conversations around inclusion, representation, and identity.

Whether you're a corporate professional, a first-generation immigrant, or simply someone who enjoys clever comedy, **D.E.I. Another Day** offers a fresh take on family, power, and finding your own voice.
