Jenna is a multiple amputee working at a magazine but only being given assignments pertaining to disabilities. Robbie, also a writer and expert on dating apps is her roommate from college. They are joined by Luke, Jenna's friend since childhood who takes up residence on their couch after a nasty break-up. Young and the Limbless sheds light on how society views people with disabilities. This comedy explores among other things the stereotyping and token hiring that people with disabilities face. Jenna uses her two quirky roommates and a Jeffrey Dean Morgan poster as sounding boards for her frustrations. Through their discussions, different points of view come to light as they move forward with their lives and keep track of Rory Gilmore's love interests.
