After getting lost in the woods, a multi-badged Woodpecker from Camp Morningwood and a wildernessy-inept Oyster Bay Beaver must set aside their differences to find their way home. Through puppetry, ukelele song and clown, the Pack Animals explore the untamed forest of mansplaining, queer love, bushcraft...and campfire songs!

Political becomes playful in this sex-positive, gender-fucking romp through the wilderness. The show, inspired by childhood experiences as Cub Scouts and Girl Guides, satirizes the gender roles we are raised in, including a 90's grunge inspired ukulele song, called "Fuck Yer Gender". The duo also parodies "Hinterland Who's Who" - with puppets that represent past relationships and sexual partners.

Each performance features a guest "mansplainer" who interrupts the show to teach the campers things they already know. And, of course, what summer camp experience would be complete without some ghost stories around a stage-safe fire.
