From Victoria, BC, Holly M. Brinkman presents *A Woman's Guide to Peeing Outside*. This one-woman storytelling show follows the events and misadventures that led Holly to write her internationally acclaimed, best selling outdoor urination handbook. This work premiered at the St. Ambroise Montreal Fringe Festival in June 2017, followed by a wildly successful and critically acclaimed run at the Victoria Fringe Festival in August 2017. The show was asked to participate as part of Western Edge Theatre's 2017/18 season and ran for 4 sold-out performances in January 2018.

A Woman's Guide to Peeing Outside is written, produced, and performed by storyteller Holly Brinkman, dramaturged by Andrew Barrett of Impulse Theatre, and directed by

Kathleen Greenfield of SNAFU Dance. Holly M. Brinkman is the other half of the hit comedy duo Pack Animals which is also performing at the Toronto Fringe Festival, 2019. She is a creator, storyteller, physical artist and teacher, living and working on the unceded territory of the Songhees and Esquimalt peoples in Victoria, BC.

Growing up in a family of storytellers, Holly has always been comfortable hamming it up in front of an audience. In Montreal, Holly Brinkman made her storytelling debut at Smut Slam in 2012, and has been a top three finalist in the Victoria Fringe Festival's "Monobrow" monologue competition two years running. She is a recurring storyteller for both Victoria and Montreal's *Confabulation* chapters and has performed in Vancouver's *The Anxiety Show* and *The Flame*.
