Monster Theatre was founded in 2000. Our first play was *Fairy Tale: A Choose Your Own Adventure Play*, an improvised street theatre show that toured the Winnipeg, Saskatoon, Edmonton and Victoria Fringe Festivals. Our second play *The Canada Show: The Complete History of Canada in One* toured across the country for nearly 20 years winning countless awards. We have developed over 40 original productions for adult and young audiences always with our signature irreverent twist on history and mythology. Monster Theatre uses the Fringe Festival circuit as a developing ground, where we create new plays, test them in front of audiences across the country, and then try to sell them to larger theatres. We've had success with this model touring shows to Off-Broadway, and longer runs at Canadian theatres like the Centaur, Bard on the Beach, The Cultch, MTYP and many more.

Plays for adults include *Juliet: A Revenge Comedy*, *War and Peace*, *Who Killed Gertrude Crump?*, *Til Death: The Six Wives of Henry VIII*, *No Tweed Too Tight*, *Assassinating Thomson*, *Hockey Night at the Puck and Pickle*, *The Seven Lives of Louis Riel*, *The Shakespeare Show*, *The Macbeth Show* and many, many more.
