Show start: 19:30

BASIC VENUE INFO - physical barriers, stairs, toilets etc.

Enter through Ground floor door, up 2 short flights of stairs (1 flight, a turn and then another - both around 14 steps straight into theatre.

We can carry wheel chairs up, if user is ambulatory and we can reserve seats for certain access needs: lip reading, sight impaired and autism requirements. We just need to know in advance.

Due to the age of the building, the theatre is not wheelchair accessible. The entrance has steps from Heath Street, and a Victorian staircase — circa late 19th century — runs from the foyer up to the main theatre level. The structure cannot be retrofitted with ramps or a lift.

TIMINGS OF EVENT- running time, breaks (interval), venue opening/ closing times**Example**

The timings of the event will be as follows, with the building open from 17.30PM:

17.30 – 19:00: company will be getting ready for the performance

19:00: doors open

19:30: show starts

20:15: show finishes

CONTENT OF EVENT - *Trigger warnings***, flashing lights, loud noises, music etc.**

The play touches on themes of grief and physical illness which some viewers may find triggering. There will be some flashing lights and loud noises. Audience members can leave the space at any time but can not be guaranteed re-entry.

SEATING

The auditorium has 55 tiered seats. Every seat has a clear view of the stage and is close to it. The room is air-conditioned year-round, and front-of-house staff are on hand from doors and throughout the show.

ADDITIONAL ACCESS INFORMATION

Five wide, modern, clean bathrooms are available on the theatre level. None are wheelchair accessible.

We do not currently have a hearing loop. We plan to fundraise for one and will install it as soon as we are able.

Assistance dogs are welcomed. Please let us know before your visit so we can make sure they have space and refreshments waiting.

GETTING TO THE VENUE - nearest tube/overground lines, step-free routes, blue badge parking areas

*We are at 28 Heath Street, Hampstead NW3 6TE — about thirty seconds' walk from Hampstead Tube (Northern line). Heath Street rises gently as you leave the station; the pavement is uneven in places, as is common across the village.
If you have mobility issues, or simply need a few extra moments to enter unhurried, please let us know before your visit and we will support you.*
