Access Measures

Relaxed Performance

Relaxed performances are open to everyone, but the environment has been specifically adapted for those who are neurodivergent and may experience sensory sensitivities, folks with communication or learning disabilities, and people who would benefit from a more relaxed environment.

The 7 pm performance on July 4th will be a relaxed performance.

Mask Mandated Performance

Mask Mandated Performances are performances where attendees are required to wear a medical face covering over their nose and mouth. Attendees can bring their own mask, and masks will be provided at the venue.

The 1pm performance on July 6th will be a masked performance.

Hailing from the boggy marshes of Scarborough, Andy Fetamean is a gender-fucking clown creature with a penchant for magic, shenanigans, shiny objects and gyration.



ARCHIE CALLED plays the role of ARCHIE CALLED.

This king is a creation of his own. Refreshingly retro, Archie is a cartoonish fool in man's clothes who never passes up the chance to put his own unique creative flair into every detail.



COYOTE UGLY plays the role of COYOTE UGLY.

Coyote Ugly (He/It) is a magic spewing, space age drifting, witchy bastard, brought to Toronto for one purpose: to bite the hand that feeds.



Devery Bess plays the role of Devery Bess.

This King will entertain you with smooth moves, with the cheesiest of puns. It's De Very Bess and it's a promise.



STEFAN FETAMEAN plays the role of STEFAN FETAMEAN.

He's Toronto's most hypermobile dancing stud with over 20 years of dance, theatre, and improv training
