AWARD-WINNING COMEDIAN JON BLAIR MAKES TORONTO FRINGE SOLO DEBUT IN "CLIP SHOW"

After winning Best of the Fest at both the **Toronto and Montreal Sketch Comedy Festivals**, **Jon Blair** is bringing his signature style of one-man sketch comedy to the Toronto Fringe for the first time with **Clip Show**, a hybrid sketch revue/comedic play inspired by the past 2 years working as a creative in isolation.

Combining solo sketch, storytelling, music, clown and more, Clip Show uses the classic format of a sitcom flashback episode as a jumping-off point for an absurd comedic adventure. When a series of escalating mishaps leave Jon trapped in the pantry on the day of his Fringe show, he's left with no choice but to search for a way out, reflect on the pitfalls of a life in the arts and, of course, use questionable segues to flashback to fan-favourite sketches from his extensive comedy career.

Skewering workplace etiquette, failed relationships, swaggering stage personas and even the cliches of solo shows themselves, Clip Show is a strange, sprawling and hilarious return to the live form from the creator of the popular pandemic-era sketch web series **Now More Than Ever.**

Jon has performed in Fringes for almost 20 years, in various comedic and dramatic plays and improvised shows. He also joined fringe-favourite troupe **Sex T-Rex** on their cross-Canada Fringe tour of **Swordplay: A Play Of Swords**, and has performed in the Halifax and Edmonton Fringe festivals with his solo sketch revues **I'm Only One Man, Live From The Garbage** and **I Hope Nothing Bad Happens**. Clip Show marks the first time he'll be bringing his eclectic brand of one-man sketch comedy to his hometown festival!
