Written by the husband-and-wife creative duo of Jesse McQueen and **Jack Creaghan**, this sharp new dramedy brings together an all-star powerhouse cast of Toronto's finest comedic actors to tell a hilarious, heartbreaking story of secret backyard resistance.

The Story: Windsor, 1966. Every Thursday, sixteen suburban housewives trade their aprons for cold beers, cigarettes, and dirty jokes at the neighbourhood's first backyard pool. "Ladies' Day" is a riotous, booze-fueled escape from domesticity—but beneath the laughter lies a powder keg of hidden truths, from alcoholism to closeted homosexuality. It's a beautiful, chaotic oasis the neighbourhood ultimately decides to stop at all costs.

A Modern Reflection on "The Good Old Days" and the real-life antics of McQueen's grandmother, *LADIES' DAY* charts the awakening of a collective consciousness. The play strikes a fierce modern chord by challenging today's internet trends that romanticize returning to traditional housewife roles, proving the solidarity these women fought for then is still under siege now.
