The film features Captain Isa. A space pilot on a solo mission to deliver desperately needed supplies to a Martian settlement. She struggles with isolation, tedious meals and the heartbreak of leaving her son. When Isa loses her hearing, she is pushed to her limits to overcome the "Sound of Space".

When writer and director, Tyler Morgan wrote the script he did not have a spaceship. After playing a zombie for two years at an escape room he knew there must be a spaceship themed room. He was right. Proxima Command near Christie Park features a full sized spaceship. After pitching the story to the owners, they came aboard as producers of the film.

A team slowly formed and came together moved by the imagination and emotional drive of the story. What started out as one person grew to include Industry professionals and Ryerson volunteers.

The production runs high in the spirit of “Let’s put on a show” with everyone pooling their props and talents to finish the film. The result is a movie with great effects, compelling acting and of course, a spaceship!
