Brianna Newman plays the role of Joule

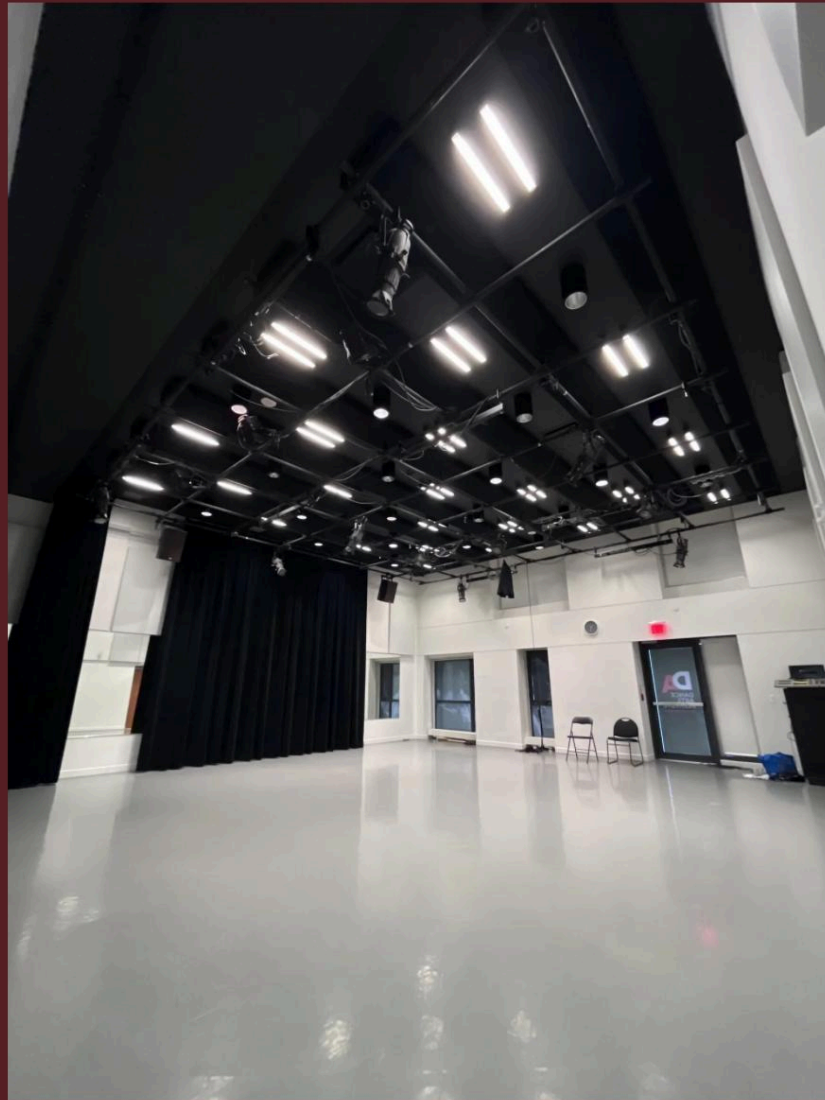


Set
