At an isolated Summer Camp, self-described 'Queen of camp' counsellor, Soren, is perturbed when her favourite camper begins acting strangely. The good-hearted counsellor must discover what on earth Jayce is up to before he ruins camp for everyone. This tragicomedy charts one girl's journey from carefree youth to criminality. Guaranteed to make you laugh, this is a thought-provoking satire of performed authority, all set at an idyllic kid's camp.

The Boy Who Cried won multiple awards and critical acclaim from Aaron Jan at the University of Toronto Drama Festival, including: President's Award for Best Production and Best Script.

With dynamic co-direction from Soulpepper Academy Member, William Dao, the cast and crew include some of Toronto's brightest young performers and designers. Crème de la Crème's recent Toronto Fringe projects have included: *Milk* (2020), *What Are You Supposed to Be?* (2021), *Honeymoon 2.0* (2021).
