About A Part of the Story

The show follows four girls and a talking mirror as they come in and out of their high school washroom, with several scenes depicting a mysterious graffiti artist. Popular friends Laureen and Amari have adopted Vivian into their friend group after her old friend group fell apart a year before the show takes place. Laureen and Amari now bully one of Vivian's old friends, Daniya, who keeps seeing their third friend, Cadence, in the bathroom mirror. Vivian is worried about how her friends are treating Daniya and her slipping grades, when new information comes to light that makes both her and Daniya rethink what really happened last year.

The back wall is covered in graffiti that changes throughout the show.

Costumes

All characters wear clothes that high school students wear such as sweat pants, jeans, leggings, t-shirts, cropped shirts, tank-tops, sweatshirts, running shoes, and sneakers. At times, one character dresses in all black with a hood covering their face.
