Relaxed Performance

Relaxed performances are open to everyone, but the environment has been specifically adapted for those who are neurodivergent and may experience sensory sensitivities, folks with communication or learning disabilities, and people who would benefit from a more relaxed environment.

The 3pm performance on July 9th will be a relaxed performance.

About 2076: A Sketch Comedy Show

This is a sketch comedy musical that contains several short scenes that are, for the vast majority of the show, separate from each other in context. In the show, two characters express concerns about what the future will be. They then happen to find a time machine and use it to take brief looks at various possible futures. The show concludes with them returning to their own time, where they present what they've learned from their journey.

Set

The set is minimal, with an entrance on either side of the stage, a projection screen in the centre at the back of the stage, and three seats that are moved into a variety of configurations between scenes during the performance.

Costumes

The costumes include a variety of bright, “retro” garments with bold colours and patterns. Additional costume pieces such as hats, artificial facial hair, and other accessories are used for certain sketches with specific characters.
