About Springtime

May and June are wanted enemies of the state hiding in a box buried under a pig farmer's barn. To pass their time in hiding, they play games, tell stories, and escape into their imaginations. When the farmer begins inviting May on excursions above ground, both women must confront how much they are willing to sacrifice for survival.

There will be one Mask-Mandatory performance of Springtime on **June 9th at 8:15pm**. Masks are required for all audience members. There will be a HEPA Air Purifier in the space, and extra masks available onsite. Exemptions are always made for access or medical reasons.

Cast and Characters

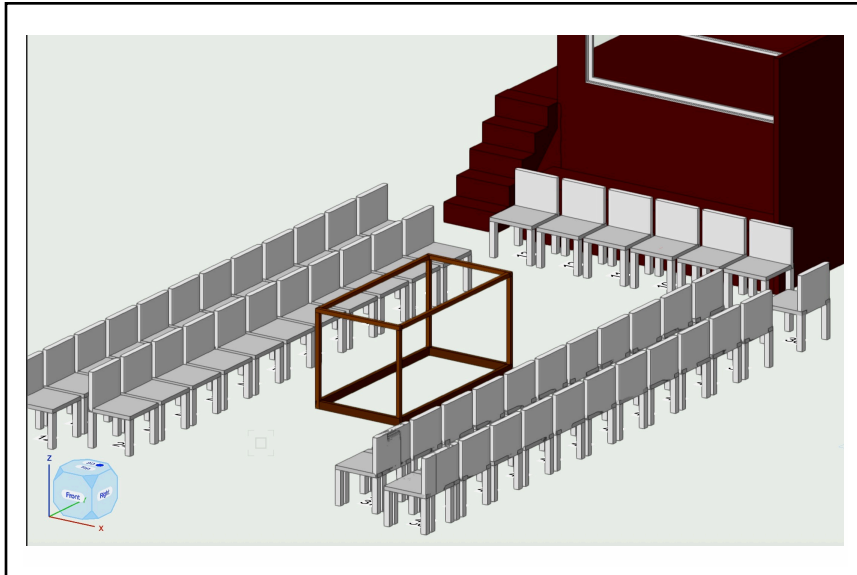


Katie Lawrence plays the role of May. She is older, manipulative, and careful.



Kendra Cordick plays the role of June. She is younger, playful, and reckless.

Set



The set is comprised of an open wooden rectangular box that stands 4 feet tall, 4 feet deep, and 8 feet long. It sits on a raised platform 20 inches tall, 5 feet and 1 inch wide, and 8 feet long, leaving roughly 2 feet of space between the platform and first row of chairs. There is a projector screen on one end.

Costumes



May wears a faded men's red Red Hot Chili Peppers band t-shirt and a pair of short black jean shorts.

June wears a faded gray men's t-shirt with a black line drawing of a man lying in bed pointing a gun at targets drawn on his feet. The image is from Roland Topor's book of illustrations *Les Masochistes* (1960). She wears a pair of long black jean shorts.

May and June are barefoot.

When it gets colder in the box, May and June wear men's flannels over their shirts.

When it gets hot in the box, June briefly removes her t-shirt, revealing a sports bra. This moment lasts less than a minute before she puts her t-shirt back on.
