Do morals have a place in politics, or is it all smoke and mirrors? This laugh out loud comedy will be running at Factory Theatre Mainspace and is sure to be a hot ticket this fringe, as MINIMUM plays at Doug Ford's front door.

This is a show that pokes fun at Premier Doug Ford's recent policies about Freedom of Information, OSAP, the proposed expansion of Billy Bishop airport and politicians in general. The set is two desks, one slightly larger than the other. Two Ontario flags, a Franco-Ontario flag and a Canadian flag are on flag poles at the back of the stage. There is a coat rack and a podium. The podium rolls forward to centre stage under a spotlight when the Premier makes speeches. A gold toilet is brought on stage.

Grace wears a black pant suit, with a white shirt underneath.

Helen wears a red skirt with a white blouse.
