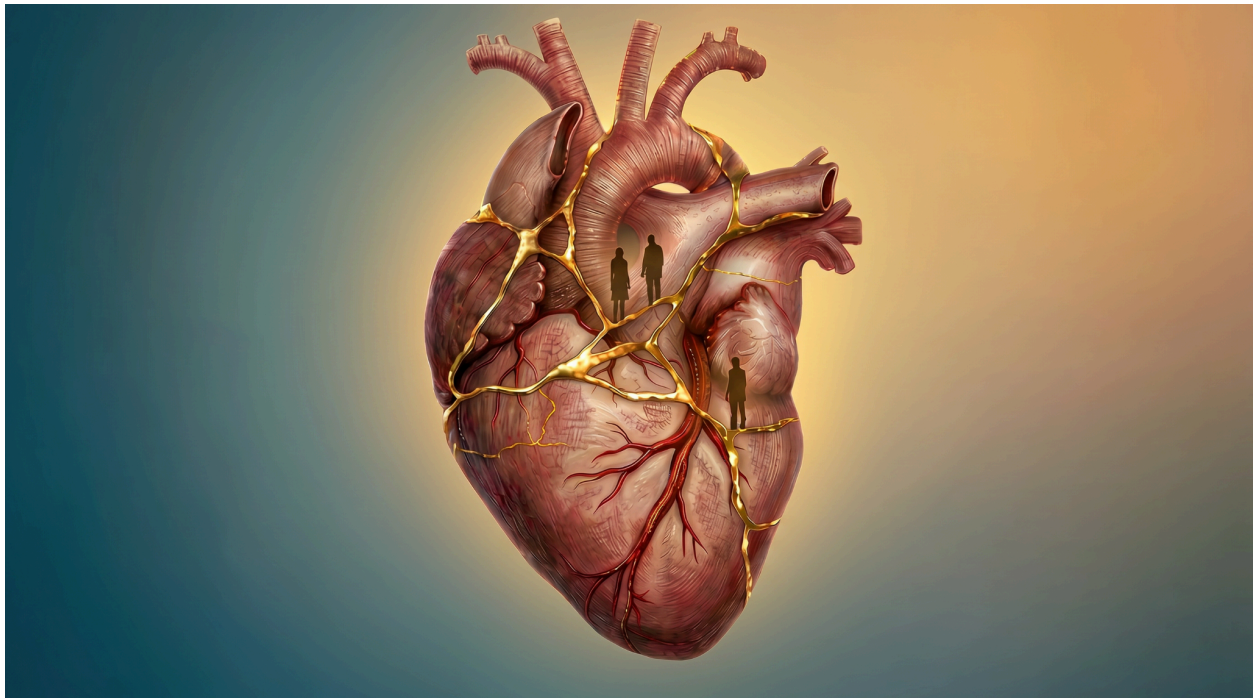

JULIUS CHAPPLE plays the role of ANDREW.

ANDREW is a man in his late 40s, who recently suffered a heart attack. He is a patient at the cardiac clinic.



CHRISTINE MOYNIHAN plays the role of WENDY.

WENDY is a woman in her 70s, who is recently widowed. She is a patient at the cardiac clinic.



LOUIS ADAMS plays the role of BOBBY.

BOBBY is a recently retired man in his late 50s - early 60s. He is a patient at the cardiac clinic.

This actor also plays ANDREW'S DAD and SURGEON in FLASHBACK scenes.



YOLANDE WILLIAMS plays the role of NURSE.

NURSE is a woman in her early 40s. She works at the cardiac clinic.

This actor also plays JEN, the wife of ANDREW, in FLASHBACK scenes.



ERIC CINNSEALACH plays the roles of PARAMEDIC, SURGICAL RESIDENT and ANDREW'S friend, PETER.

PARAMEDIC, SURGICAL RESIDENT and PETER are all in their 40s and appear in FLASHBACK scenes.

Set



A diagnostic clinic for heart patients. Stage right is a Waiting Room with six pink chairs in an L-shape.

Upstage centre is an Exam Room, with a walking pad treadmill.

Stage left is the Prep Room, with two blue armchairs and a black exam table.

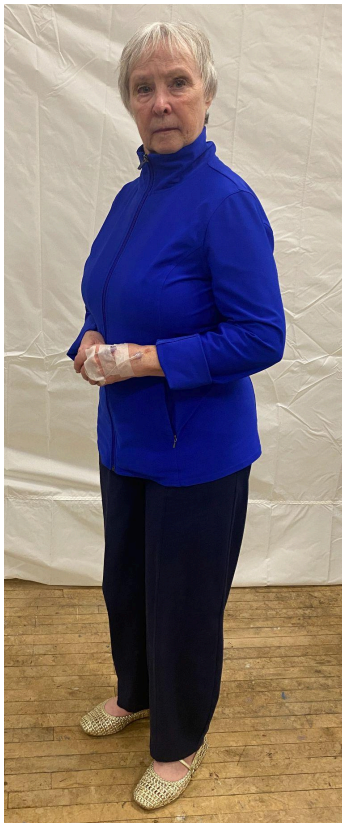
Downstage centre is a common area used for FLASHBACK scenes. The FLASHBACKS illustrate a University Party, ANDREW'S Kitchen, a Bar, an Operating Room, a Hospital Room and ANDREW'S Childhood Home.

Costumes



JULIUS CHAPPLE plays the role of ANDREW.

ANDREW wears a red t-shirt and black track pants. He has an IV catheter attached to his left hand.



CHRISTINE MOYNIHAN plays the role of WENDY.

WENDY wears a royal blue zip-up sweater and navy blue yoga pants. She has an IV catheter attached to her left hand.



LOUIS ADAMS plays the role of BOBBY.

BOBBY wears a black zip-up sweater, blue shirt, black track pants and gold chain necklace.



LOUIS ADAMS also plays the role of ANDREW'S DAD.

ANDREW'S DAD wears a brown bomber jacket, white shirt and black track pants.



LOUIS ADAMS also plays the role of SURGEON.

SURGEON wears a navy blue scrub shirt underneath a light blue surgical gown, black track pants, a grey surgical cap and blue surgical gloves.



YOLANDE WILLIAMS plays the role of NURSE.

NURSE wears a set of grey scrubs, and a stethoscope around her neck.



YOLANDE WILLIAMS also plays the role of JEN.

JEN wears a grey shirt, grey pants and a dark blue denim jacket.

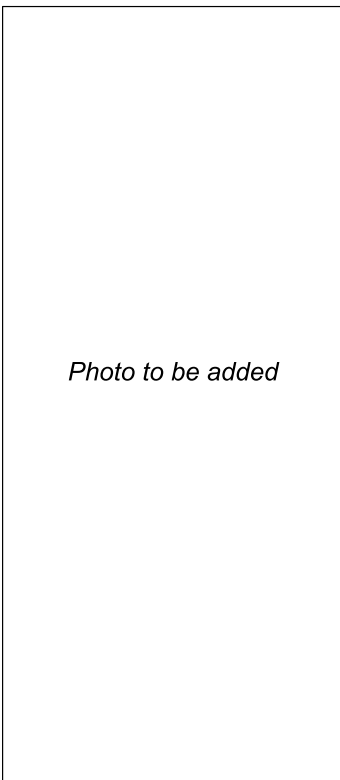


In another scene, JEN wears a grey shirt, grey pants and a dark grey cardigan.
