What Are You Supposed to Be? is a found footage film that follows a retiring, later-in-life party princess, Leah (Leah Cherniak). Leah is not your run of the mill princess; she runs a youtube channel where she debunks myths and fictions because she believes that stories turn kids into brats. When we meet her, she has just left what was meant to be her last party, but she gets a special request to do just one more. On her way there, she meets her shadow, Taranjot (Taranjot Bamrah) who is eager to learn Leah's party-princess magic. The pair unexpectedly arrive at a party with just three children (Eliza Lane, Ellen O'Gorman, and Joanne Perez) and one of them seems more like an adult.
