Zaniq King plays the role of Rose. Eselynn's best friend and confidant.

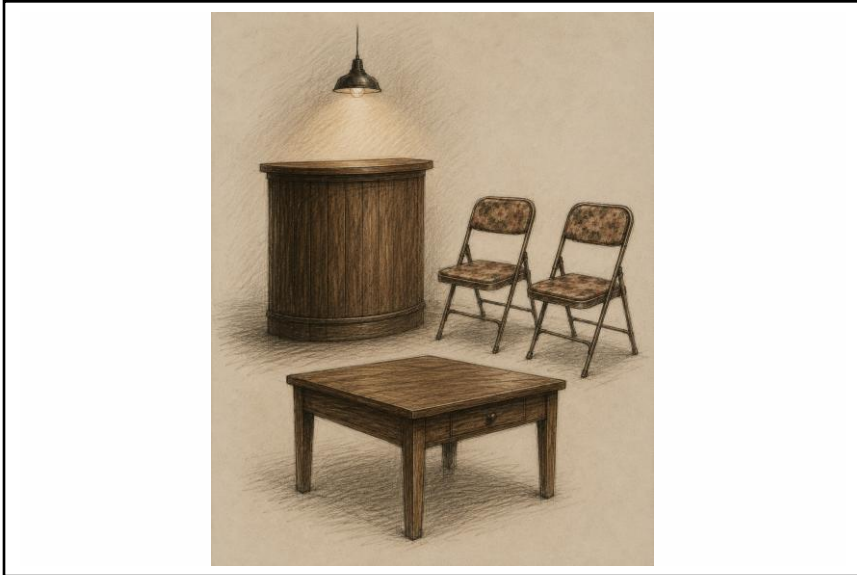


Jonathan Isaiah Tucker plays the role of Thomas. Eselynn's love interest.



Ophilia Davis plays the role of Mama, mother of Eselynn. She also plays Eselynn's sister, Anita.

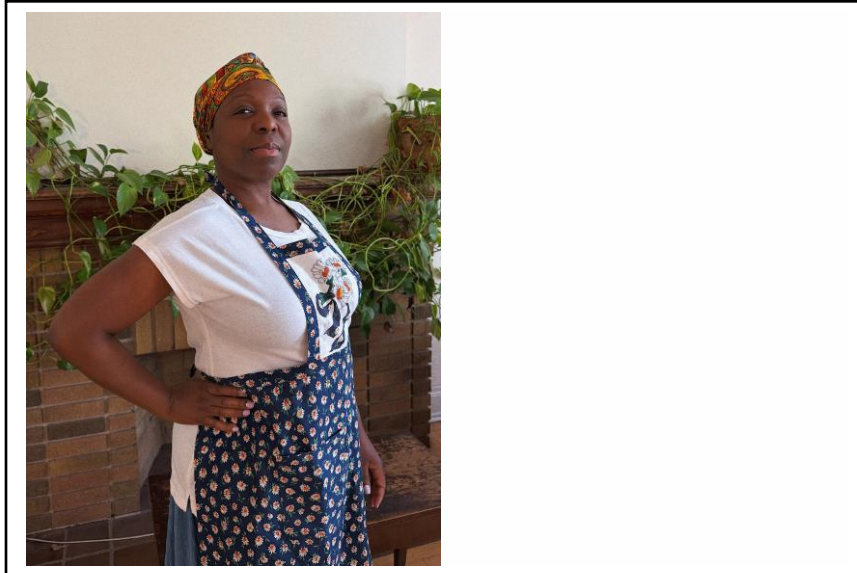
## Set
