Set



The set design will be very minimal, using the stage itself as the primary playing space. At most, there may be a small platform to allow for variation in levels.

The setting for the seven stories will be showcased mostly in costuming and props. For example a large, flat, wooden horse prop for the Trojan Horse story.

Costumes



Each actor wears a neutral coloured base costume. They add simple pieces on top for each story they're a part of.

For example in the Stock Market Scene all the actors playing the Stock Market Ensemble wear oversized suit jackets.
