

White Man's Indian follows Eva, a young Cree girl who leaves her reserve community to attend high school in the city for the first time. Thrust into an unfamiliar world shaped by colonial expectations, racism, and cultural disconnection, Eva struggles to find where she belongs while navigating friendship, family trauma, identity, and the lasting effects of intergenerational colonial violence. Through a series of vivid memories and encounters, she confronts painful experiences of abuse, isolation, and self-doubt before beginning a powerful journey toward reclaiming her Indigenous identity, resilience, and sense of self. Told with humour, vulnerability, and fierce honesty, *White Man's Indian* is a coming-of-age story that examines what it means to survive and heal in contemporary Canada.
