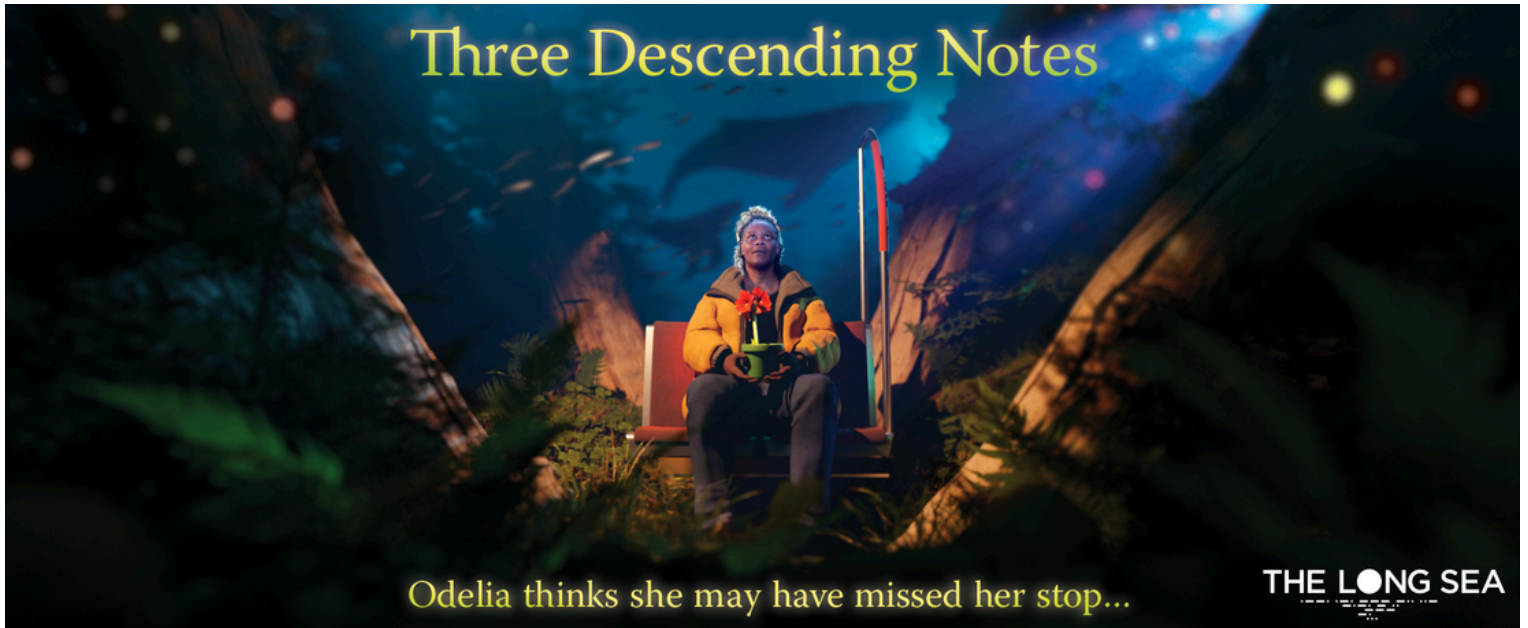

Access Measures

There are no additional access measures for Three Descending Notes.

About Three Descending Notes

“Three Descending Notes” is about Odelia, a woman in the early stages of dementia, who gets lost on the subway and goes on a fantastical odyssey to find her way home.

Odelia is a live actor on the stage, but the rest of the cast appear as holograms, or illusions. This is created by using a projector that uses lasers and mirrors, and a special scrim called a “Pepperscrim.” There is live singing and recorded music. In order for the illusions to work, the theatre must be kept very dark.

There is no audience interaction, and the cast never comes into the audience.

Run Time

"Three Descending Notes" is 50 minutes with no intermission

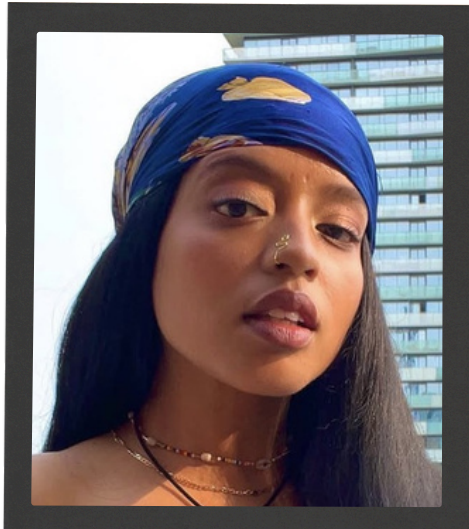
Content Warning and Advisories
