who? hú 狐 Where Myth Meets Survival

A fox walks into the end of the world. *who? hú 狐* is a new bilingual (English/Mandarin) play at Tarragon Theatre Mainspace as part of the 2026 Toronto Fringe Festival and yes, it's exactly as wild as it sounds. Two immigrants. A cave. A nightmare. Then: a fox. Blending dark comedy, Chinese mythology, and physical theatre, the play builds a world where the apocalypse is somehow both bleak and hilarious, and where the fairy tale ending is real, just don't ask too many questions about how we got there. Funny, unsettling, and unexpectedly hopeful, this is the kind of show that sneaks up on you. Developed through a collaborative creation process rooted in Chinese folklore and the very online horrors of our present moment, *who? hú 狐* is presented by Who? Spirit Production at the 2026 Toronto Fringe Festival. They eat, rest, dream, talk, dance, take selfies, and somehow keep dancing. You should be there for it.
